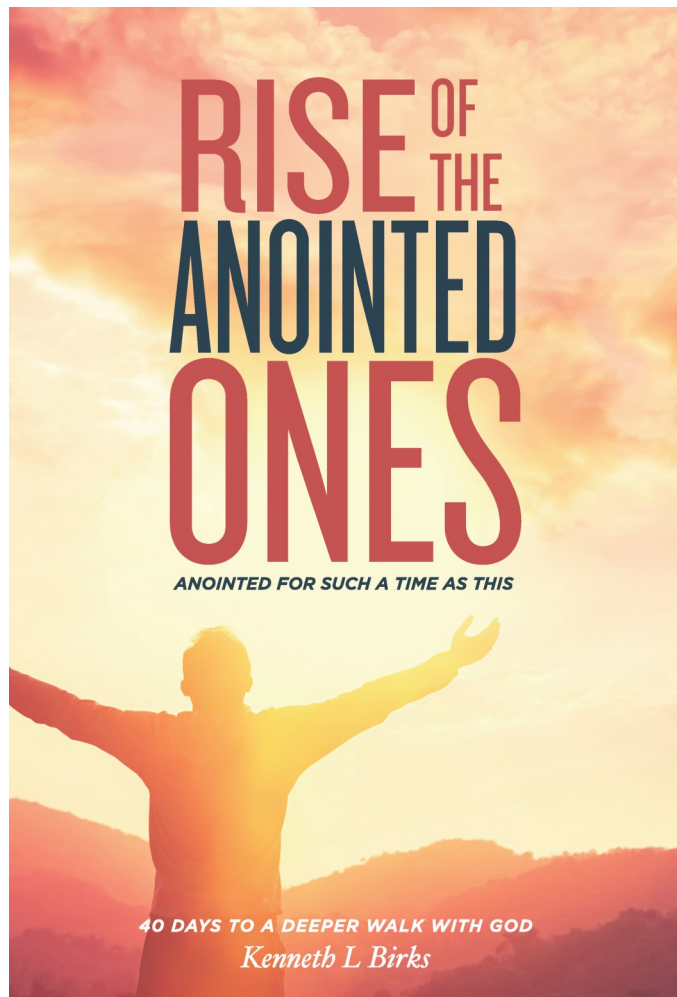

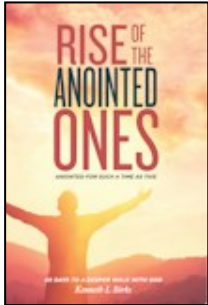
As both Peter and Paul revealed in their epistles, we have been given the divine nature and the mind of Christ to enter this wonderful state of oneness with the Godhead.

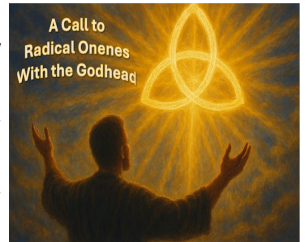

About the Firm Foundational Lessons



In the seventh chapter of Matthew's gospel, Jesus teaches the "Parable of Building on the Rock." Emphasizing the importance of a strong biblical foundation, He contrasts the foolish man who built his house on sand with the wise man who built his house on rock.

Peter and Paul did not just write lofty ideas in their epistles—they revealed a staggering truth: you have been given the divine nature and the mind of Christ. This is not a theory. It is your invitation to live in radical oneness with the Godhead.



But here is the challenge: Will you activate what is already yours? Will you refuse to settle for surface-level faith and press into the depths of God's heart as revealed in Paul's letter to the church at Ephesus?

Paul's prayer in Ephesians 1:17–19 is not a polite request—it is a battle cry for believers to rise up and receive revelation! He asks God to flood us with wisdom and insight so we can truly know Him, see with spiritual eyes, and grasp the magnitude of our calling, inheritance, and the explosive power at work within us.

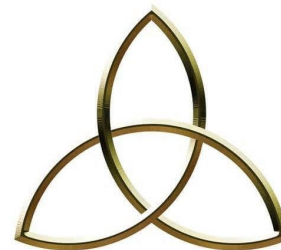
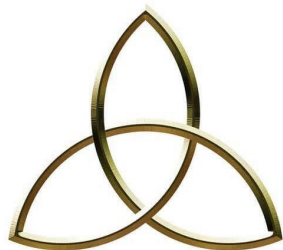

Will you live like His DNA is alive in you? Will you fight for unity and fullness until the world sees Christ blazing through His people? It's up to you to make that decision.



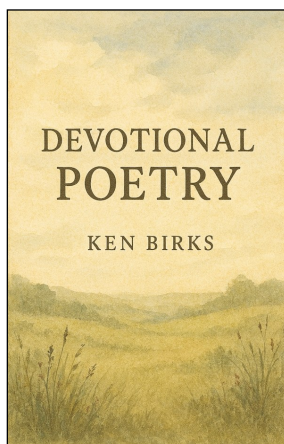
A Call to Radical Oneness with the Godhead Podcast

Bible Study

“Call to Radical Oneness with the Godhead”



This lesson calls believers into Radical Oneness with the Godhead, rooted in Jesus' prayer in John 17. Jesus' intercession for believers to be one—just as He, the Father, and the Spirit are one—is presented not as a hopeful wish but as a guaranteed destiny, spoken with perfect faith and divine authority.

To walk in this oneness is to embrace a deep, experiential knowledge of God that produces spiritual strength, decisive action, and bold exploits (Daniel 11:32). This union is not optional; it is the heartbeat of heaven and the essential posture for believers living in an age of accelerating darkness, moral collapse, and end-time turbulence.

The study warns that surface-level faith is no longer sufficient. The Church is entering a defining moment where unity with the Godhead becomes the lifeline for navigating chaos, carrying hope, and walking in supernatural power. Believers must repent of shallow faith and rise as beacons of light, refusing fear and passivity.

Radical oneness requires commitment and sacrifice, echoing Romans 12:1–2. As believers lay down their lives, God crowns them with wisdom, transforms their thinking, and aligns their thoughts with His. This exchange awakens divine DNA within them, shaping them into Christ's likeness and empowering them to live boldly, pray daringly, and take Spirit-led risks.

The study emphasizes that believers have already been given the divine nature and the mind of Christ, and must activate these realities through intimacy, obedience, and renewed minds. As the Body matures under Christ the Head, it is destined to reflect His fullness and rise as a unified, unstoppable army (Joel 2:7–8).

Ultimately, this is a call to warriors, not the fainthearted—a summons to stand against darkness, shine with God's glory, and embody the hope and power of the Holy Spirit in a world desperate for light. The time to rise is now.
